## Become a qualified Amateur Radio Operator for Jamboree On The Air 2025

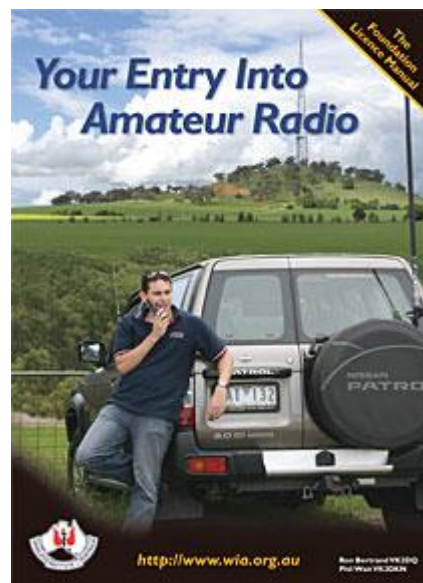


**Amateur radio** has been used by scouts and guides to communicate with each other, locally and around the world, since 1957. As a qualified amateur radio operator, you would be able to share this unique experience with your guide or scout youth members, either within your own group or as part of larger JOTA amateur radio station.

Your pathway into Amateur Radio commences with the Foundation entry level qualification. There is no morse code to learn, just some basic theory and regulations, and practical setup and safe operation of amateur radio equipment.

**The next Foundation level training and assessment weekend is 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> August 2025, at Sutherland scout hall.**

On Saturday, training covering theory, regulation and practical components, then assessment on Sunday by ACMA accredited assessment team.
